MEMORANDUM OF T. LEWIS.

From .. Rear Admiral, First Battle Squadron. 8.6.36
To .. Admiralty. Read. 1438.

Addressed Admiralty and Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean. Adly Yaghen Pasha has completed new Cabinet and Parliament will be opened Thursday next after which in absence of further complications High Commissioner proposes to visit Palestine for a few days. In these circumstances High Commissioner considers retention of "Resolution" at Alexandria after his departure no longer essential though presence of battleship has undoubtedly a quieting influence. He desires me to say prompt arrival of "Resolution" was very prominent factor in averting trouble during present situation.
